Day of Departure:

Getting to the Airport, Your group can avoid delays by traveling together to the airport. Some group leaders opt to charter a bus to drive them to and from the airport especially when distance is a concern.

We will take care of any Covid test requirements for returning home by scheduling a time while touring for your congregation to take part in and have plenty of time before you leave.
